Ian Fawks DO, FACOFP of Springfield, MO was awarded the 2024 James A. DiRenna Sr., DO Appreciation Award by the Missouri Society of the American College of Osteopathic Family Physicians (MSACOFP).

Dr. Fawks was honored at a ceremony on January 20 during the 2024 MSACOFP Winter Family Medicine Update. This award recognizes organizations or individuals that have shown continued support for the osteopathic profession and family medicine.
